2. Matt Stouts 25th anniversary with the Township was November 1st. Are we ready to do evaluations? Do you want to do them on yearly in December or do you want to do them on anniversaries. Damon's was October Matt's is November Lisa's September and mine depending if you go by when I started (January) or when I received this position (August).
3. October Burials \$775.00 Total, 1 resident cremains burial \$325.00 and 1 nonresident cremains burial \$450.00.
